

Titan V7.5 Content Library Enhancements

Changes to Content editing and Block Library in Titan CMS

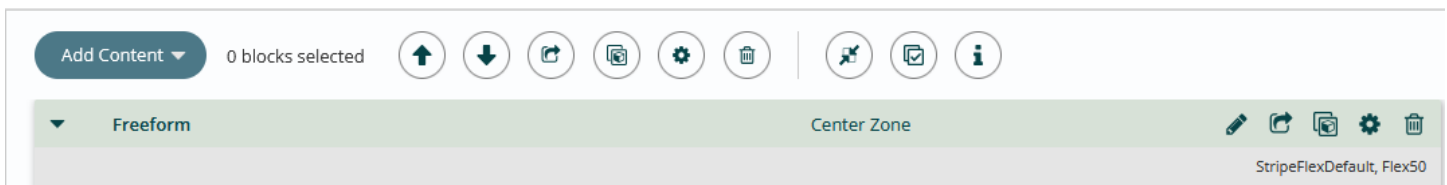
The primary goal of this version is to enhance the usability of the Content Library, which has quickly become one of our most utilized tools for originating content.

- **Add Content Menu Revamp** - We have placed greater emphasis on using the Content Library for new content.
- **Bookmarks** - Users can easily bookmark Block Copies so they appear in the Add Content menu.
- **Theme Awareness** - Block Copies now track supported Theme in order to allow in-context filtering of the Content Library and Add Content menu for the page currently being edited.
- **User-driven Organization** - We now offer users the ability to create and arrange Library Folders for organizing Block Copies using a drag and drop interface.
- **Keyword Search** - Users can find Block Copies using a keyword search of Block Copy names, descriptions, block types and block content.
- **Multiple Online Libraries** - We extended the Content Library to support multiple Online Libraries, providing a way to receive content examples from external sources other than TitanCMS.com.

A secondary goal for this version is to provide greater flexibility and efficiency in organizing content.

- **Duplicate Block** - A new utility function has been added to allow authors to duplicate the selected blocks on the current page.
- **Full Block Stack in Block Copy Editor** - When editing Block Copies, it is now possible to insert new blocks and rearrange the blocks in the Block Copy.

Action Bar Icon Updates



Move - select a block(s) and use arrows to move up or down.



Share - **New**; select block(s) to share in Content Library (previously called Copy)



Duplicate - **New**; select block(s) and use to immediately adding same block(s) to current page



Edit Attributes - select block(s) to edit Block Attributes/styling



Delete - select block(s) to delete



Collapse View - select block(s) to toggle collapse of block content



Select All - click to select all blocks on a page



Block Info - click to show/hide of block properties

Change from Copy to Share

When you are ready to re-use a block or blocks on a page select and click the **Share** icon:

This dialog has one change that allows you to assign it to a Theme that is supported.

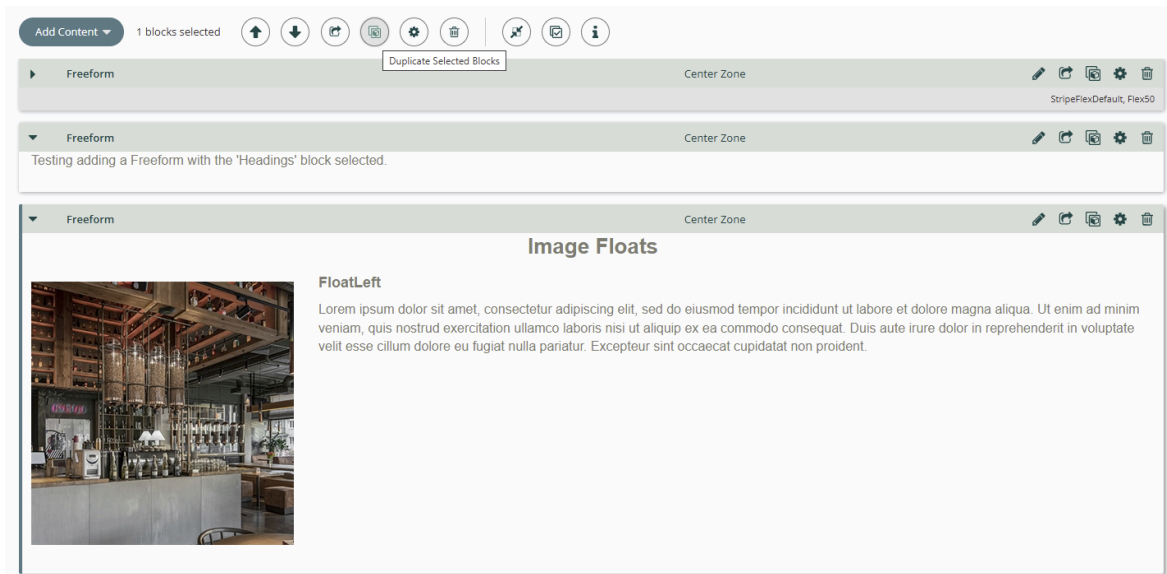

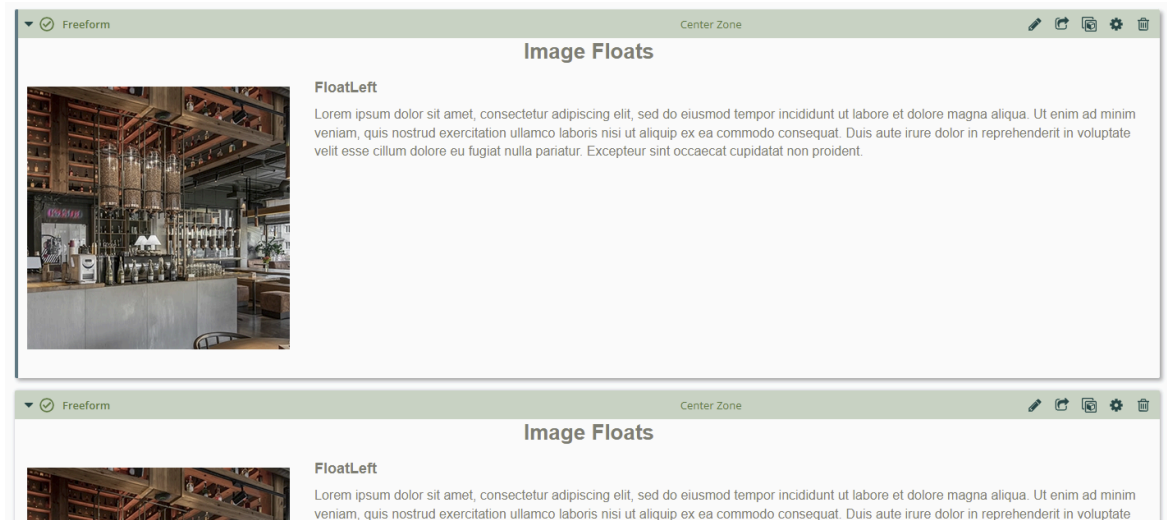


Duplicate A Block

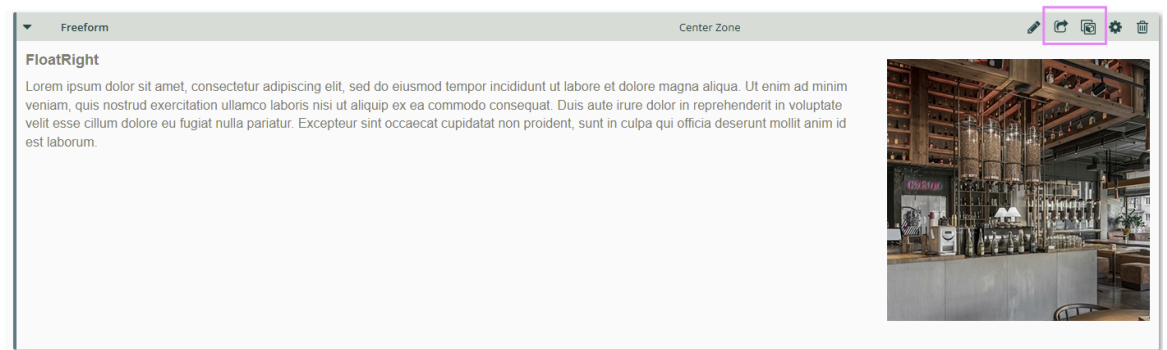
When you are ready to duplicate a block or blocks on an existing page you are working on select and click the **Duplicate** icon:



Your new block(s) will appear below the selected one:

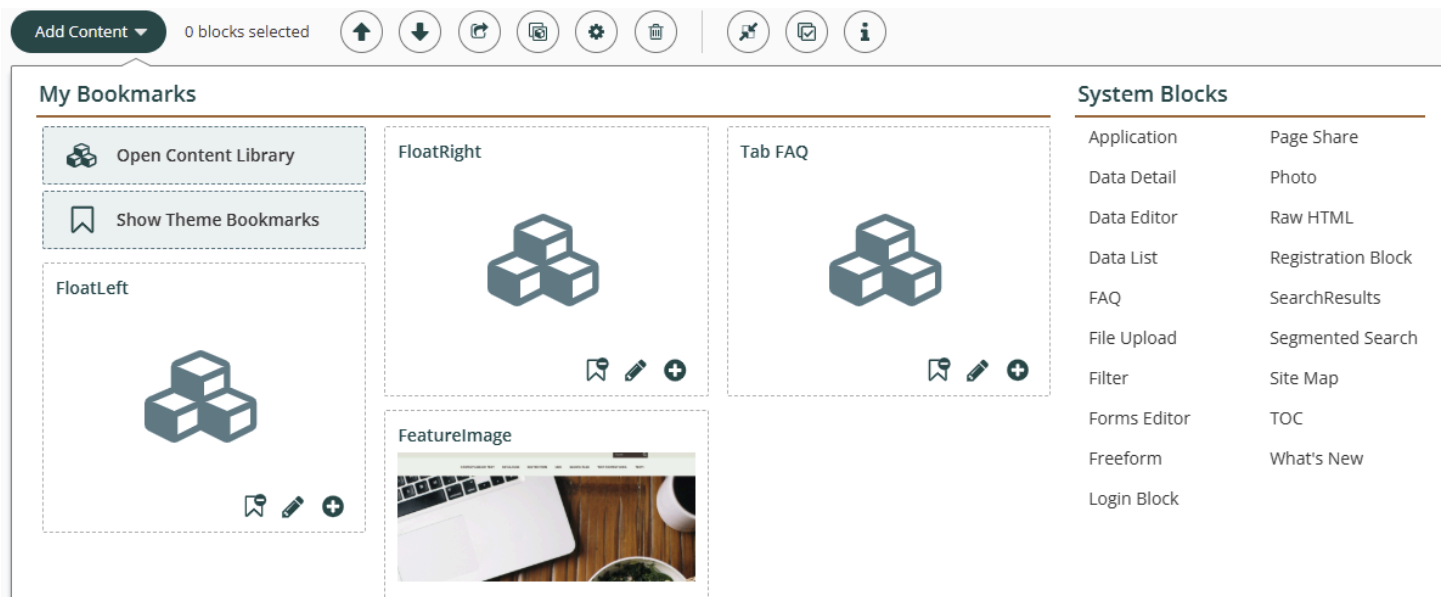


You also have these New icon options on an individual block level with the same functionality as above:



Working with the new Content Library

When you click the **Add Content** icon on a page you will see a new Dialog Box. The default view is showing all Bookmarks with System Blocks to the right.



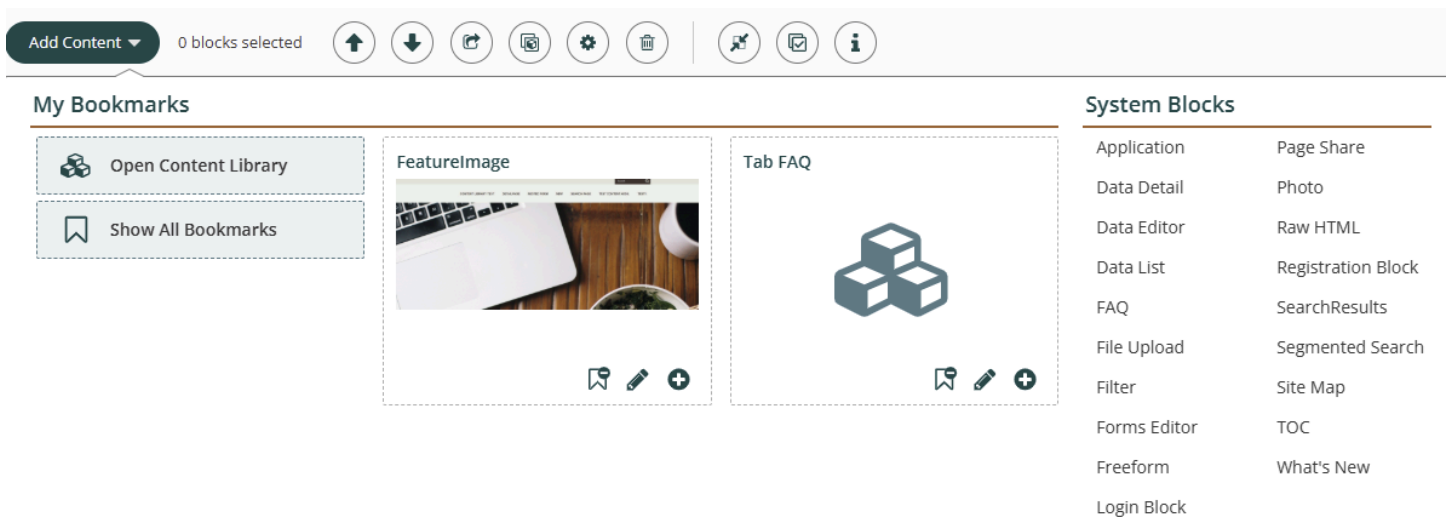
New View:

My Bookmarks is now your go-to spot for quick selection of content from the Content Library

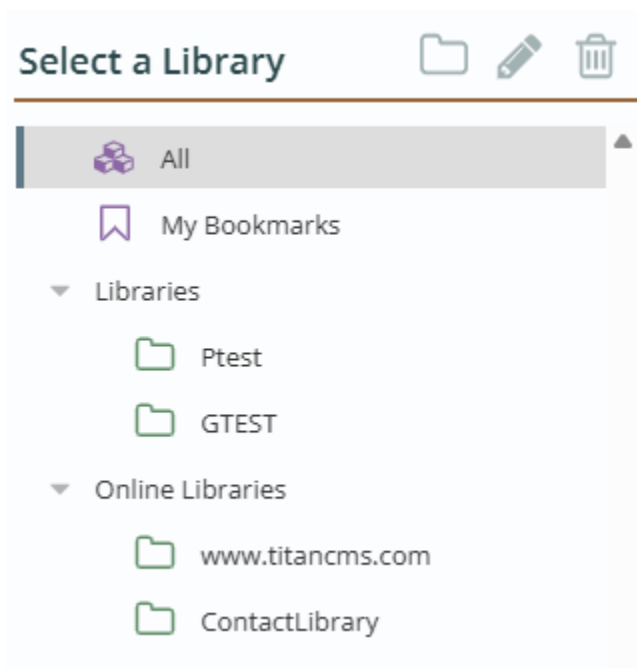
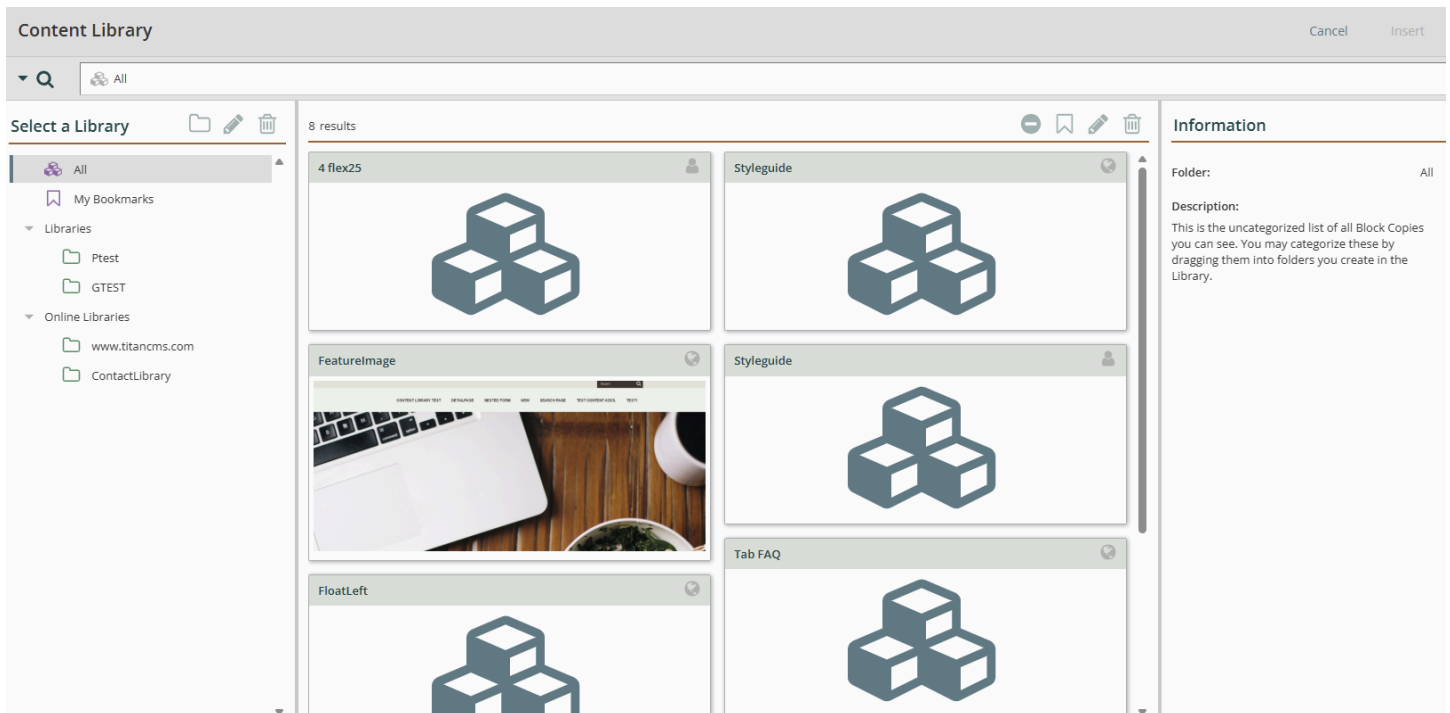
System Blocks now appear on the right of the dialog box

Open Content Library this opens the Content Library

Show All/Theme Bookmarks this toggles between bookmarks you can create; it defaults to **All Bookmarks** (above) and toggles to just **Theme Bookmarks** (below)



Open the **Content Library** and you will see a new Dialog Box. **New Navigation** - replacing Global/Personal and Online Templates you have new selections.



All - this displays Global and Personal uncategorized list of all Content (Block) Copies you can see. You may categorize these by dragging them into folders you create in the Library.

My Bookmarks - this displays just your Bookmarked Content (Block) Copies seen in the add content Menu.

Libraries - this section of the Content Library allows you to organize Block Copies into categories or Libraries. Create and move Library folders, and then drag Block Copies into a structure that will make up your library.

Online Libraries - this section is Titan External Content Libraries for use with themes built in Titan CMS framework.

Working with All Items in the Library:

Select a Content Item to work with and the icons allow you to



Add a bookmark - this adds the block copy to your bookmarks

Edit an item - same dialog as previous version

Delete an item - this deletes a block copy with a confirmation dialog

Working with Bookmark Items in the Library:

Select a Content Item to work with and the icons allow you to



Delete a bookmark - this removes the block copy to your bookmarks

Edit an item - click to edit same dialog as previous version

Delete an item - this deletes a block copy with a confirmation dialog

Working with Libraries:

Select a Library



Create a Library - click to create a new library





Edit a Library - click to edit an existing (selected) library



Delete a Library - select and click delete to remove a library

In center content view you will see new block library icons denoting:

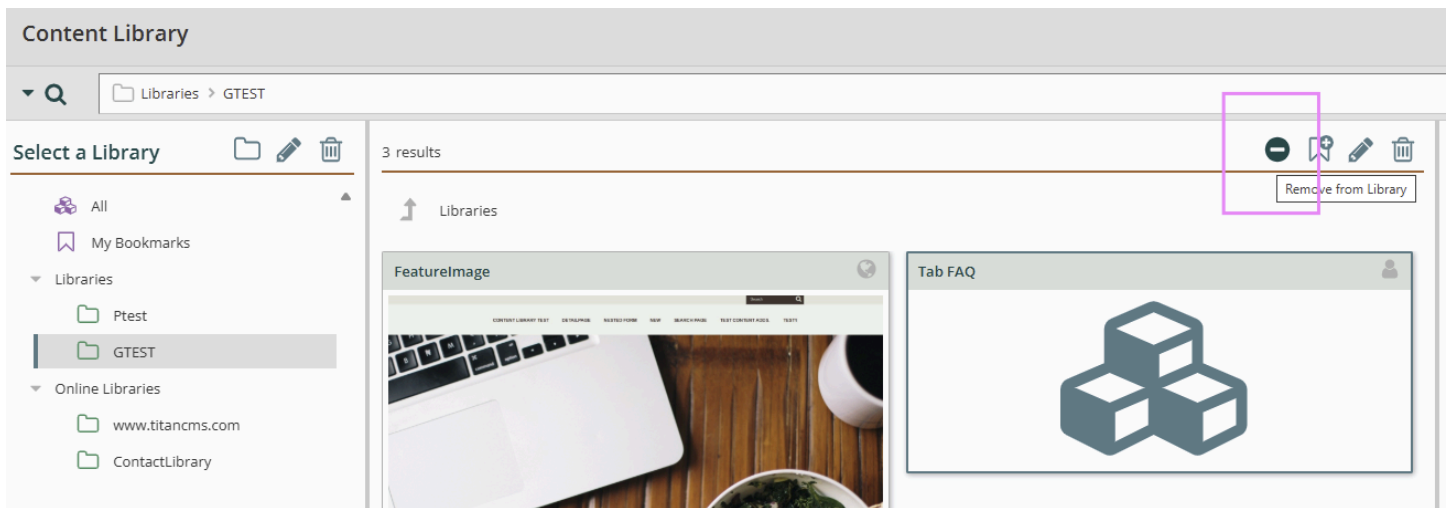
1.  Personal - this denotes it is just for you
2.  Global - this denotes it is global for everyone

Then actions you can take with the **Libraries**:



Remove from Library - this is used to remove a copied block from a Library

When in a Library select a block and click Remove from Library

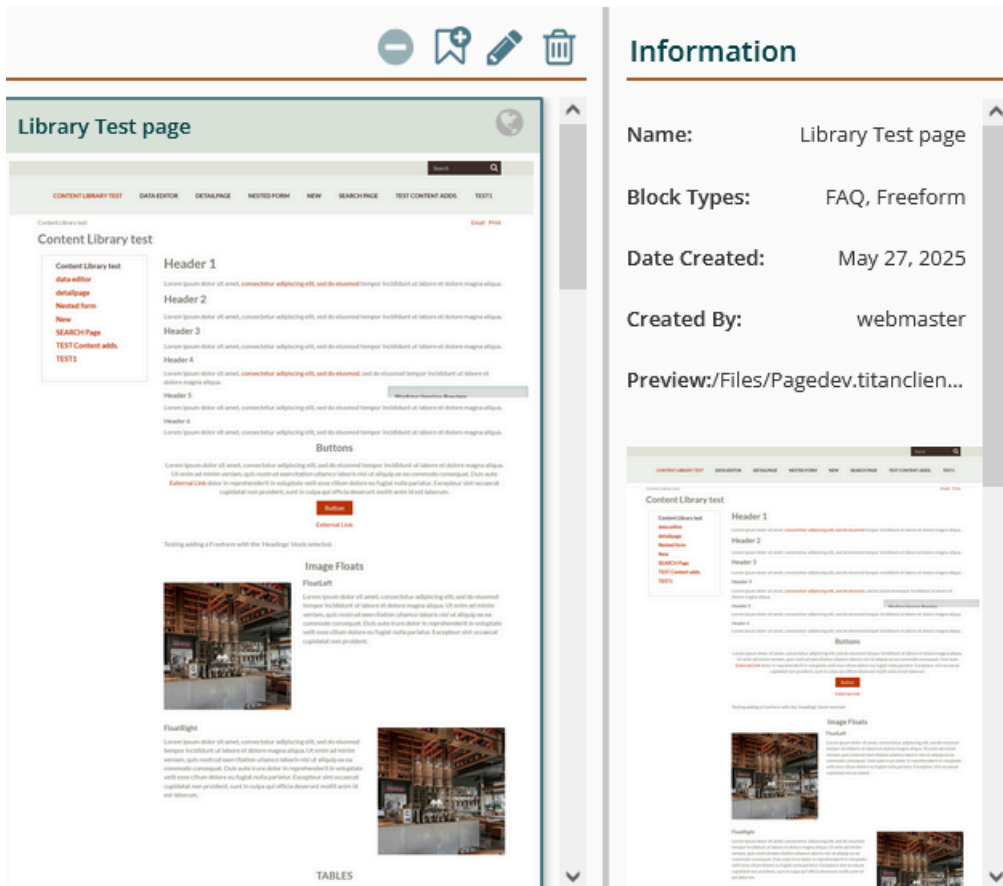


Bookmark - add or remove a Bookmark

Edit - click to edit same dialog as previous version

Delete - a Library select and click delete to remove a library

Select a block in library and see detail information in right column
